

STARTING IN 2022

Fresno County will require multi-tenant commercial and multi-family residential property managers and owners to provide green bins to all tenants for the collection of food waste per Senate Bill 1383.

Tenants must begin discarding food and green waste into a green bin. If you don't have a green bin, contact your property owner or manager.



What goes into the green bin?

NOW – food waste without a plastic bag!

- Food Waste (e.g., Fruits & Vegetables, Coffee Grounds, Meat, Eggs, Dairy in small quantities)
- Grass Clippings
- Leaves, Weeds & Plants
- Garden Trimmings

The Basics

How Tenants Collect Food Scraps:

- **Use a countertop pail.** You can use your own plastic tub with a filter and lid to capture food waste.
- **Line the pail with a clear plastic liner to prevent leaks.** Be careful. Clear plastic liners cannot be discarded in the green bin with your food waste.
- **Find a place to store it.** Under the sink, next to your trash can, or in the fridge.

To Reduce Food Odors

Keep food waste in the fridge or freezer until collection day.
