While they each may make our daily lives easier, the long-term impact of improper disposal can be harmful to our community and the environment. Residents are now able to dispose of these items at the Environmental Compliance Center (ECC) for free. To help you better understand what's accepted and what's not, we've categorized various Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) items below!



HOME

- Aerosols (Cooking Spray, etc.)
- Bleach
- Batteries (All types)
- Cleaners
- Drain Openers
- Electronics & Small Appliances
- Fire Extinguishers
- Flea / Tick Control
- Fluorescent Bulbs & Tubes
- Furniture Polish
- Glues
- Hair Spray / Coloring Products
- Hobby / Artist Paints
- Laundry Soaps



- Home Medical Syringes & Sharps
- Nail Polish & Remover
- Old Thermostats
- Photo Chemicals
- Stain Removers

YARD

- Chemical Fertilizer
- Fungicide / Herbicide (Weed Killer)
- Insecticide
- Bug Spray
- Rat Poison
- Treated Wood
- Solar Panels



GARAGE

- Aerosols (WD-40, etc.)
- Antifreeze
- Auto Batteries
- Automotive Fluids
- Car Wax / Polish
- Driveway Sealer
- Engine Degreaser
- Fuel / Gasoline / Kerosene
- Lighter Fluid
- Paint / Stain / Varnish
- Paint Stripper / Thinner
- Pool Chemicals
- Roofing Tar
- Small Propane Tanks
- Solvents / Adhesives
- Used Oil & Oil Filters



NOT ACCEPTED

- Some Containers (Empty or over five gallons)
- Ammunition
- Explosives or Fireworks
- Household Trash
- Infectious or Medical Waste
- Large Appliances
- Mattresses
- Over-The-Counter Medications
- Prescriptions
